Grocery Donations

The Recipient of the Trinity Grocery Cart for the Month of July 2024 is the Interfaith Food Pantry. The Pantry is open to help on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month between the hours of 4:45 and 7:45 p.m. All residents are eligible with proof of residency.

Food sources for the pantry include Feeding America, local churches, community organizations, food drives, individuals, business donations and local purchases. The shelves of the Pantry are stocked by volunteers. The Pantry serves about 270 families and many seniors.

The food that is available includes; meat, dairy, fresh produce, canned goods and personal items. \$2,000 a month is spent for eggs and milk.

Items that are needed to fill the shelves of the Pantry include canned fruits and vegetables, pastas with sauce, meals in a box like hamburger helper, cereal, canned meats such as tuna, chicken, or ham, peanut butter and jelly, baby diapers, shelf stable food products and monetary donations.

Volunteers are also needed when the Pantry is open. There are usually two shifts that work during that time. Let's fill the Trinity Grocery Cart for the month of July for the Interfaith Food Pantry.

Church office hours are 8:00-4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. However, some staff members have vacations scheduled or are out of the office.


