<b>A P P L Y</b>	<p>In today's gospel lesson, Jesus sends out the disciples two by two, empowering them to heal people and drive out evil spirits. But he also tells them to take nothing with them but a staff and the clothes on their backs, thus making them dependent on God's provision. After his resurrection, Jesus tells his followers, including us, to go into all the world, baptizing and making disciples of all nations, relying on the Holy Spirit and God's provision. We live in a very different world than the disciples did, but relying on the Holy Spirit and God's provision in reaching the world for Christ are two things that will always be needed to accomplish that task.</p>
