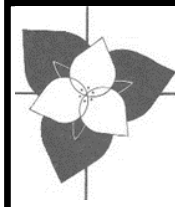

Monroe House

The warming center will be closed at the end of March. It was suggested that we take our leftover soups, veggies and cookies to the Monroe House. So, for April 2nd and April 9th the GLO Committee will deliver to them after the church service. ***Thank you to all that have helped with this very worthy cause.***

Lenten Coins and Loose Change

Our Loose Change and Lenten Coins for March and April will go to Monroe House.

Monroe House is a new non-profit organization dedicated to alleviating housing insecurity in Stevens Point. It will provide a low-cost, sober transitional living option for 24 individuals in the old Turn of the Century building at 1700 Monroe St.

In addition to stable living arrangements, Monroe House will offer residents information about community organizations and resources. Residents will receive assistance in dealing with issues such as alcohol and substance abuse, mental health, family challenges, acquiring and maintaining employment, and general life skills. The goal is to help residents transition from Monroe House to permanent housing. Residents will be accepted after an application and an interview, with highest priority given to those who pledge to follow the program and house rules. Each resident will pay a program fee of \$90 per week or \$350/month, which will include a room, access to a communal house kitchen, and a food pantry stocked with basic food.

Please give generously to this worthy cause. Pour your loose coins into the collection plate on Sunday or contribute checks or bills in envelopes that clearly designate your gift. Monroe House is also looking for volunteers for a wide variety of tasks.
